Take Action! Stop the Dump!

Tell them about the risks of leaking liners and contamination of the ground water we drink.

Explain to them that dump liners leak. Science shows that when they do the pollution spreads and spreads underground.

Encourage them to tell Doug Ford to keep his promise. Stop the dump.

Don't let the federal government forget that it has responsibility. Catherine McKenna, Minister of the Environment and Climate Change agrees that the Fisheries Act “prohibits the deposit of deleterious substances in water frequented by fish”. Leachate from the dump could contain lots of chemicals which fish or people will not like to swim in. Marc Garneau, Science Minister, has written to us sympathetically too.
